**By Rail.**

Bath Spa is approximately 10 - 15 minutes by taxi. For information on train times and operators call National Rail enquiries on 08457 484950.



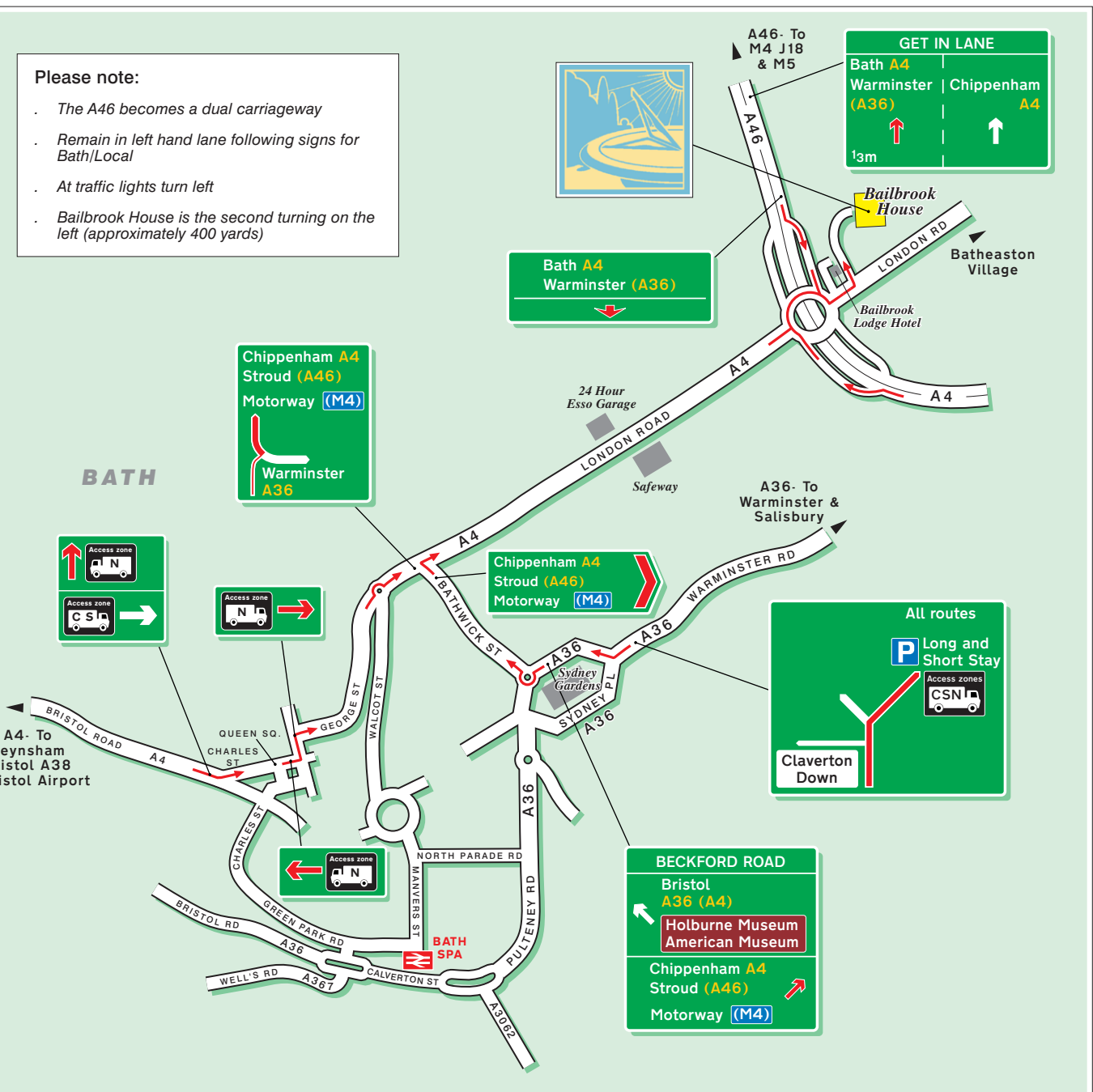
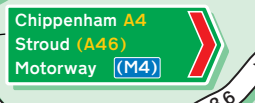
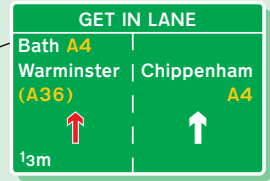
**By Air.**

Bristol Airport is approximately a 45 minute taxi journey.



### Please note:

- The A46 becomes a dual carriageway
- Remain in left hand lane following signs for Bath/Local
- At traffic lights turn left
- Bailbrook House is the second turning on the left (approximately 400 yards)

***Getting here by road >***

Bailbrook House occupies a magnificent setting in 20 acres of gardens and parkland, overlooking the Avon valley on the edge of Bath. About 8 miles from the motorway, Sundial's latest executive business meeting venue is perfectly connected for the M4 corridor and southern England. The M4 can be easily accessed from the M5 at Bristol and we advise travellers from the south west and north to use these motorways to avoid Bath city centre which can be congested. Travellers from the south may by-pass Bath through Bradford on Avon on the A363.

***By rail or air***

Frequent fast trains to Bath - a ten-minute taxi ride from Bailbrook, takes just 80 minutes from London Paddington which has excellent connections to Heathrow.

Bristol has a fast growing regional airport with numerous national and international connections and is about 30 minutes drive away, we also have facilities to land helicopters in the grounds. (See online for GPS co-ordinates)

If you wish to be met from the airport or the station, please let us know in advance and we will be happy to arrange transport for you.

***From the M4: Junction 18 >***

- Leave the M4 at junction 18 and follow the signs for Bath on the A46.
- Continue on the A46 through the village of Pennsylvania and on towards Bath.
- As you approach Bath the road becomes a dual-carriageway and goes down a long hill.
- At the bottom of the hill take the slip road signed to Bath City Centre.
- This leads up to a roundabout, take the first exit, London Road - local traffic.
- The drive into Bailbrook House is about 200 m on your left from the roundabout. It is the second left-hand turn, immediately after the entrance to Bailbrook Lodge.
